









Pendent with 3/4 inch Conduit

Loosen the screw on side of the light, removing the bracket from Canopy light by pulling it slightly out, just leaving the ring on bracket. (See the Step 1 above)











Surface mount

1. Remove the lens and metal plate by unscrewing the screws.
